

PROPOSED SAFETY AND IMPROVEMENTS FOR SARAWAK FA

SAFETY IN STADIUM NEGERI

1. Strict enforcement and body checks at entry gates for firecrackers especially.
2. Entry for ticket holders only because there are instances where non ticket holders get entry at the second half of the game.
3. Open the exit gates only 10 minutes before the game ends. No entry for non-ticket holders.
4. Designate a special place/seating for away fans at the open area, or at the end of the grandstand area with police/RELA protection. Don't place them at strategic locations because this should be reserved for the Sarawak FA fans.
5. Security personnel should be placed and planted among the fans, and not just merely standing on the running tracks. If they must watch the game, put them at the very end of each seated segment to allow them to monitor the crowd.

SAFETY OUTSIDE STADIUM NEGERI

1. Station security personnel outside the stadium to catch those trying to scale the fences/walls to gain illegal entry.
2. Have RELA and Police personel on standby outside the stadium before and after games as well.
3. Have policemen do rounds during games, and before games to curb 'ulat parking'.

SAFETY OF OUR FANS FOR AWAY GAMES

1. Co-ordinate with local ultra groups/supporter groups for away matches and games so that all can seat at one designated place.
2. Make sure security forces help protect fans when watching away games.

IMPROVEMENTS WANTED TO STADIUM NEGERI

1. Improve toilets, and have it cleaned before game intervals.
2. Paint the stands including the open area red and black to give the stadium an identity.
3. Improve the speakers so that any announcements can be heard all over the stadium.
4. Improve the stadium internal fencing to allow not only better visibility for spectators during the game, but also tighter security.
5. Replace or change the seats at the grandstand terraces. There are too many broken chairs. To save cost, maybe a long bench would be more practical.

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6. Play Sarawak FA related songs before, between and after the game to make everyone familiar with it. This can hopefully spur better crowd action during games.
7. Increase the number of toilets. If needed, add in 'movable toilets'.

IMPROVEMENTS WANTED OUTSIDE STADIUM NEGERI

1. Traffic wardens regulating traffic flow before and after the matches.
2. All roads leading to and from the stadium until PUSTAKA Sarawak are converted to one way roads for at least 30 minutes after games.
3. Parking wardens should direct traffic and encourage drivers to park in a one way direction to facilitate better flow of traffic after matches.
4. Better lighting at parking areas particularly those far away from the stadium.
5. Police and Rela enforcement rounds during football matches at places where fans vehicles are parked, especially those parked far away from the stadium.
6. Rela/Police should be used to curb 'ulat ticket' and 'ulat parking' around the stadium.
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
